Permanent Meadows, Seeding, etc.
Col. F. D. Curtis gives much information on the subject of permanent meadows in the American Agriculturist:

At one time, not having manure sufficient to manure a field all over when it was sown with wheat, unmanured portion was left on the early part of the winter and clear cow dung and horse manure was scattered on the wheat. The field was a side hill, but covered with the manure and was sown to the roots of the wheat and grass, and a fine crop was harvested. The experiment dispelled the notion that manure on the surface of a hillside goes to waste, and also demonstrated the beneficial effects of surface manuring. This year, being the second cropping of clover and timothy on this land it has produced four large loads to the acre and looks very promising for the coming crops. Too little grass was given this year. A large amount is wanted for the night and morning pastures, which the ground is prepared. This is one of the greatest drawbacks to success in grazing. The ground should be pulverized to a fine tilth, and, if necessary, the clover should be gathered up and carted away to feed heavy stock; an implement made especially for gathering these clover into heaps, when they can be carted away to feed heavy stock; a post bar, a roller is a great find to grass seed, and a preformed necessary for to firm or press the ground into close contact with the seeds, making the plants less liable to be thrown out by freezing.
