TIMELY TOPICS.

The works of the immense clock which has been put up in the Board of Trade building in Chicago are pronounced to be the finest specimen of the work of the great Westminister Palace clock in London, but with some additions and improvements adapted to its commercial purpose. It is constructed of iron, brass and steel, and weighs ten tons without the bell, the latter adding some 4,500 pounds more. The pendulum alone weighs 750 pounds. In its arrangement the work is divided into a time train, a hand train, and a striking train, these several trains comprising separate machines, resting side by side on separate frames of cast iron. The train is operated by a separate weight, and the three weights together reach some 3,500 pounds. The hammer that strikes the bell weighs eighty pounds, the clock work is below the dial, and there are ten feet ten inches in diameter, and the bell is above them or 250 feet above the ground. The pendulum swings one way in two seconds.

Pedro Aguirre, an old Mexican at Arizaca, Arizona, who is rich in land and sheep, is said to thrive also from a system very like porridge. Must Stay in Prison.
