

HOUSEHOLD HINTS.

Remove flower pot stains from window sills by rubbing with fine wood rasp and rinse with clear water. Washing pine floor in a solution of one pound of copperas dissolved in one gallon of strong lye gives oak color. Stains on ivory may be taken out by washing with soap and water and placing it, whilst wet, in the air to bleach.
