A new process regarding the right to citizenship is up recently before the United States circuit court for Oregon.

The facts in the case were as follows: A boy born of Chinese parents, in this country was sent to China with his mother and upon his return to America after several years was denied the right to citizenship as he had no certificate of prior residence as required by law.

The case was finally argued to the United States circuit court on the ground that he was a native of this country and that his residence in China for an indefinite period did not expatriate him, nor amount to a renunciation of citizenship, since such a right can not be renounced by the parents of a minor.

The court held that the point was well taken, and sustained the appeal by allowing the child to land. It would consequently follow that this Chinese boy is a citizen of America. On reaching his mother will have the right to exercise all the functions of American citizenship.
