

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE WATER WORKS OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRMINGHAM...

SECTION 1. That the rules and regulations hereinafter named shall be considered a part of the laws...

SECTION 2. No person except a duly licensed plumber will be allowed to tap or make connections with any of the public water mains...

SECTION 3. Plumber shall make full and complete returns to the Clerk of the Board of the uses for and to which water is to be used...

SECTION 4. Plumber in making returns shall give name of street or lot line in which the attachment has been made...

SECTION 5. No service connections or other attachments to any of the water mains shall be made except by means of a lead pipe...

SECTION 6. No tap or pipe other than the above will be allowed, nor will any parting using other than the foregoing be allowed to connect with the water works...

SECTION 7. Any plumber or pipe fitter who shall be guilty of a violation of any of the by laws hereinafter provided by the Commission...

SECTION 8. All water rents shall be paid semi-annually, the first day of September...

SECTION 9. No person except the authorized agents of the Board or the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department shall take water from any public or private fire hydrant...

SECTION 10. For punishment of a member of the Board, a duly authorized agent of said Board, or the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department...

SECTION 11. Persons wishing water must get a special permit from the Clerk for each building, for each separate installation...

SECTION 12. Every service pipe must be provided with a stopcock for each consumer, easily accessible...

SECTION 13. The Board or its representatives shall be authorized to enter and have free access to all reasonable hours to premises to ascertain the location of all hydrants, pipes or other fixtures...

SECTION 14. Persons taking water must keep their service pipe and all fixtures connected therewith in good repair...

SECTION 15. In sprinkling streets each water taker must confine himself to one-half the width of the water main...

SECTION 16. Any consumer or consumers of water who shall permit others not members of the family or other device using the water from his or their hydrant...

SECTION 17. Hydrants, hose attachments, faucets, or any other device which the consumer may adopt for obtaining water from the service pipe shall not be used...

SECTION 18. Any consumer or consumers of water who shall permit others not members of the family or other device using the water from his or their hydrant...

Hydrant, faucet or other device until such hydrant is removed to some sanitary place on said premises.

SEC. 18. Parties desiring water for cisterns, tanks or other use of faucet at their own expense...

SEC. 19. Hydrant, tap, hose, water cocks, urinals, bath-tubs, or other fixtures...

SEC. 20. The use of all hydrants shall be regulated by the Board of Water Commissioners or Crumpton Council.

SEC. 21. Any person wishing to discontinue the use of water works water, must give notice...

SEC. 22. Aerial pipe intended to supply two or more districts or tenants, and where only one stopcock is used...

SEC. 23. No tap or pipe other than the above will be allowed, nor will any parting using other than the foregoing be allowed...

SEC. 24. No claim shall be made against the Village of Birmingham, for the breaking of any pipe or other fixture...

SEC. 25. No permit shall be understood to authorize anything not explicitly and truthfully stated in the application...

SEC. 26. No person authorized to open hydrants shall delegate his authority to any other person, or suffer the same to be taken from any house of said Village...

SEC. 27. No person shall connect any pipe with a stopcock, or make any other connection with a stopcock...

SEC. 28. Connection with the service pipe must be laid at least four and one-half feet below ground...

SEC. 29. No opening of the street for tapping mains will be allowed when the ground or the surface is below the level of the street.

SEC. 30. Any person not an authorized agent of the Board who shall take any excavation for the purpose of laying a water, gas or sewer pipe...

SEC. 31. Any violation or failure to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance, or failure to comply with this act...

SEC. 32. The right to alter or amend any of the foregoing rules or regulations shall be reserved to the Board of Water Commissioners...

SEC. 33. In all cases where the water in the main pipes does not exceed the size prescribed in Sec. 30 of this ordinance, the rates shall be as follows:
