### AT HOME.

Editors of the Evening.

An opportunity of sending the promised letter to the Yellow Springs, Mich., publisher, at home again, will be a pleasure to me with the better chance of doing so just now. To describe the indelible 1 will not make pretense, but endeavor to give a faint idea of nature's wonder, then displayed.

In Northwestern Wyoming, in the midst of the Rocky Mountains, is a tract of land 60 miles long by 35 miles wide, that in 1874 was set apart by Congress as a national resort and pleasure ground for the enjoyment of the people. In this boundary are grouped more natural wonders than can be found anywhere else, in fact, in the world. The Yellowstone National Park Association has been formed from the government the right to erect and maintain the various points and to convey the roads through the park at a certain fixed rate. Roads have been constructed to the attractive points as far as possible and more will be constructed in the future. The wonders of the park are the hot springs, mountains of volcanic glass, petrified forests, cataracts, canyons, hot lakes and valleys.

The hot springs proper are those that boil with an overflow, those not overflowing are called cold springs. These hot water jets are called geysers. These geysers are of almost any form, some are at great intervals, minutes, hours or days, others irregularly with intervals of months. Some stop for a long time and then begin again.
