The first that it will encourage a certain class of debtors to wait for the sale and have the auctioneer announce them bought by their friends, and the second, that the person who buys in good faith must take the claim which he purchases, and also any defense which the debtor may have. (It is to be noted that some more desirable to make the sale of a garment a cash transaction, except in the case of persons of undoubted responsibility.)
