Our school is better equipped, and better prepared for good work than ever before in its history. THE HIGH SCHOOL.

We have no hesitancy in saying that our High-School is one of the best in the state. Last spring we were again visited by a committee from Michigan Colleges and are continued on the Diploma List. Our graduates can be admitted with exemption to any of our colleges. Birmingham has 300 villages and cities, which justify this distinction. Our High School is the second largest in the country. 51 numbers each as large as Pontiac High School, although our village is but one-seventh as large as Pontiac.

BUSINESS COURSE.

We have lately adopted Williams and Rogers' Book-keeping. This book is used nearly all the best business Colleges. Our regular course takes six months' work Book-keeping, but we are ready to give, in addition to the above, a more extensive training, obtaining the subject throughout the year. Our Superintendent, in addition to his long and varied experience, where he has been for many years, has been in the village of a whole, as academy and state institute work, has this summer been teaching in the Michigan Normal and Normal Instruction. The work in book-keeping will be largely practical, each pupil can take up the work where he is prepared to begin, and work as fast as he chooses. None will be allowed to take this course without a High School, except those whose college matriculate in years.

NORMAL COURSE.

The 260 teachers of our county who are teaching on 3rd grade certificate can secure a 2nd grade salary, or drop out of the teachers ranks. In addition to our regular course we will offer opportunity to receive Algebra and General History and our grade studies. Instruction will also be given in School Law and Pedagogy.
