Some states will send no delegates, and only one set can be seated. It will not be proper on the other hand, to shut a state out entirely because of contests. Each must have representation in the organization of the convention.

It should not be supposed that the National Committee reserves to itself the power to decide contests. That must finally be done by the convention itself. This much, however, the National Committee will do, and its action must have an important bearing on the result in the convention.

The importance of these decisions upon the convention cannot be overestimated. It will be the duty of the National Committee to decide and instruct the secretary which delegates are entitled to seats.

The National Committee selects to act as a majority vote the temporary and permanent chairman of the convention, that to say, it selects a name for each position, to be presented to the convention. A bitter contest may arise within the National Committee over these selections.

The real work of the convention, leading up to and providing for the selection of the National ticket, will be done by the National Committee. The National Committee will be connected by telegraph with the chairman's desk, that he may easily ascertain the name of every delegate who may claim recognition. The scheme, it is said, will do away with the usual amonous system of recognizing delegates by claiming the majority of the votes in the first round.

The telegraph facilities for dispatching to every corner of the Nation the results of the convention will be complete. Nine new copper wires are strung from St. Louis to Chicago and six from Chicago to New York. All the wires will be run into the Auditorium. Worned cables can repair for repairs to any number of telegrams and operators' restaurants and cafes, where the best of St. Louis can be had before them at prices that make them a bargain.
