The split which occurred in the Prohibition party at the national convention at Pittsburgh some weeks ago has caused a break in the party in Michigan at the state convention at Lansing. There is now a Prohibition party and a Nationalist party working against the evil of drink, but radically differing among themselves as to what they wish to do in the country. The Nationalists call themselves broad gauge. They believe in temperance, woman suffrage, governmental control of railroads, the referendum, prohibition, restriction of immigration, and other reforms. The Prohibitionists stand on a one plank platform—the prohibition of the sale of liquor.

The Nationalists met in the armory with 150 people present. Chairman A. E. Moore, of Detroit, opened the hall. After prayer by Rev. E. R. Clark, of Edgewood, J. S. Evans, of Branchburg, presented a resolution that the state central committee was to be elected by district. The platform committee reported favoring prohibition, woman suffrage, free trade, silver, restriction of immigration, government ownership and control of monopolies, resolution of the national debt, and other reforms.
