MATTERS OF INTEREST TO AGRICULTURISTS.

Some Up-to-Date Hints About Cultivation of the Soil and Yields Thereof—Horticulture, Viticulture and Floriculture.

Subsoiling. Plowing of any kind, including subsoiling, should be a regular part of a sudden deepening, over the former cultivation of the land, writes W. F. Massey in Home and Farm.

Grass in Orchards. Only by experience and study can a man know how to apply the general rules of farming.

Disinfection of Stock Quarantines. There is no doubt that much disease among stock might be prevented by proper disinfection of all quarters.

Experiments with Cereals. The Maryland Experiment Station has been conducting a series of experiments with cereals, from which they draw the following conclusions:

1. In the variety tests with wheat for a period of six years Pultz leads, with an average yield of 27.3 bushels per acre.

2. With two crops, corn and wheat, the increased yields produced by different amounts of lime, placed the limit of profit with an application of forty bushels per acre.

3. The most favorable time for seeding winter oats in this latitude seemed to be about September 1.
