

# THE DEWEY CUP

The arrival of Dewey in New York Sept. 26, two days ahead of time, changed the reception program to a considerable extent.

Friday, parade of warships, with the Olympia at the head, up North river to Grant's tomb, to fire salute. Admiral Dewey taken ashore at 9 p. m. to spend the night.

Saturday—Admiral Dewey driven to the City Hall park, loving cup presented on behalf of the city.

Sunday—Lunch on the land parade and a smoker at the Waldorf-Astoria.

When the citizens' committee reached the Olympia Thursday, Flag Lieutenant Brumby stood at the head of the admiral's gateway. Capt. Lambertson was close by, Secretary Downes went up first, and as he was greeting the lieutenant, Admiral Dewey came down the ladder from the after-bridge and took position on the quarterdeck.

Secretary Downes, as representative of the mayor, was presented to him and Capt. Lambertson by Lieut. Brumby, and then in turn came Mr. McKelvey, Senator Dewey, Richard Croker, William McAdoo, Gen. Howard Carroll, Warren W. Foster, Bernard J. York and Chief Devery.

"Come to my cabin, gentlemen," said Admiral Dewey, leading the way to his quarters, where the two six-inch guns

Then Admiral Dewey spoke at some length of the reasons which operated to bring him home ahead of time.

"The Olympia has been steaming at the uniform rate of nine knots an hour since we left Gibraltar," he said. "Several days ago we knew that we would arrive before Thursday unless we

Where we have met them and they have been in such contact with us as to learn that we mean to treat them well, where they have seen that we mean what we say, there is no trouble. They stand by us

### Second Spectacle of the Dewey Celebration Saturday.

### THE OLYMPIA'S SAILORS LEAD.

Form a Guard of Honor for the Carriage Containing the Admiral and Mayor Van Wyck. Sixteen States Represented in the Procession.

Before the eyes of a countless host passed the great land parade of the Dewey celebration in New York, on Saturday, Sept. 26.

The parade started from Grant's tomb at 11 a. m. It formed in the avenue and cross streets east of River-street, between the streets forming Fourth street on the south, One Hundred and Twenty-sixth street on the north and Columbus avenue on the east.

The troops were forming while Admiral Dewey was on his way by boat from the foot of Warren street to Clarkmont, the main street of the parade at 10:30, and half an hour was consumed in placing the guests and their escorts in carriages in the proper order.

Olympia's Men Lead.

There were 2,000 sailors and marines in line. The men of the Olympia were at the head of the column marching directly in front of the four-baroucarriage containing Admiral Dewey and the mayor. Sousa's band of 130 pieces, the finest marching band ever put together, furnished the music for the Olympia's train.

In the naval division were the officers and men who were decorated at the battle of Santiago and Montojo's fleet in Manila bay.

In the two carriages immediately following the main guard of honor were Dewey's captains at Manila—Coghlan, Wildes, Dyer and Lambertson. Every branch of the service was represented in the 2,000 troops forming the regular army division, including the West Virginia cadets.

Practically the entire strength of the national guard of New York, 15,000 men, were in line, with Gen. Theodore Roosevelt at the head, square on a facing as his special escort.

Fifteen regiments had formed in line. The visiting troops marched in the order of the admission of their states to the union—Maine, Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Maryland, South Carolina, North Carolina, Ohio, Indiana, Missouri, Maine, Florida and Texas.

Famous military organizations which have done much to give lustre to the American army were in line with the younger veterans who are to win new glory during the war with Spain.

### ADMIRAL RECEIVES HIS MEDAL.

Grateful Words from the Recipient of All-Precedent Honors.

New York, Sept. 26.—Admiral Dewey made the longest speech of his life when he responded to the welcome of Mayor Van Wyck's welcome to New York. He said:

Mayor and Gentlemen—Of course it would be needless for me to attempt to make a speech, but my heart appreciates all that you have said.

How is it that you have overrated my work so much I cannot understand. It is beyond anything I can conceive of why there should be such an uprising of the country. I simply did what any naval captain in the service would have done. I believe Admiral Dewey said Mayor Van Wyck, "no tongue can ever utter or pen write an overestimate of what you did for your country. The city of New York has made to commend me the receipt you in commemoration of the event."

"How magnificent, how beautiful how splendid!" exclaimed Admiral Dewey as he received the medal. "It is the most beautiful thing that has ever happened to me. I wish that I could give it to you."

Route of Festival Days.
