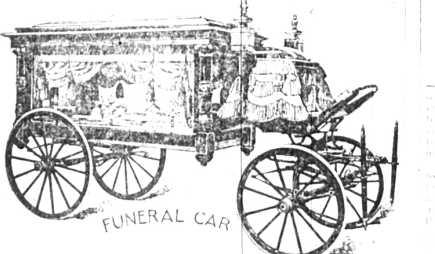

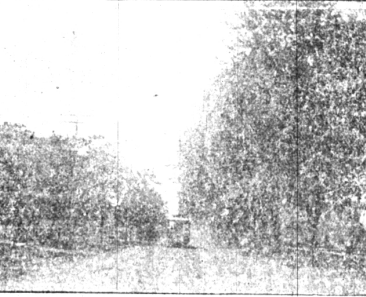
JOSE VACANT HOUSES.

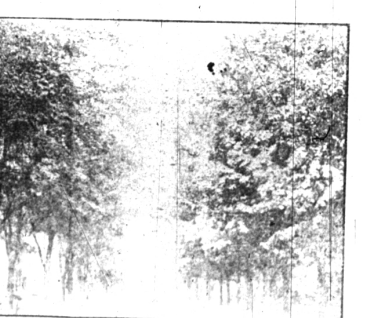
