THE DUTY OF MOTHERS.

One Bird Green in Winter. Red in Summer.
Mr. Wimer Stone addressed the Biological club of the University of Pennsylvania recently on the "Moult of Birds."
This subject, said the speaker, is one that has interested me for a long time, but it seems to have been generally neglected by ornithologists. All birds moult regularly once a year, this is a physical necessity, for the wearing of the feathers makes their replacement in the case of an imperfectly fitted moult to be continued. This annual or post-natal moult occurs at the end of the nesting season. The feathers which are worn out during the nesting season are gradually and during its progress the bird has never more than one or two feathers missing at once. The moult is a process which is controlled by the nervous system. Professor Dwight, the moult takes place during the winter. The wing feathers moult together with the innermost coverts, and the outer feathers moult successively.
