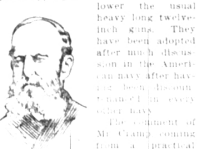

Crane, the veteran naval superintendent, has created a sensation by his letter to the navy department concerning the application of the superimposed turret in the recent type of battleship. 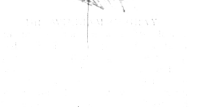
The object of Mr. Crane's letter is to point out the practical advantages of the superimposed turret and will receive the highest consideration and appears to be based upon the experience of metal armor in actual engagements, as well as upon his own judgment. A number of the advocates of about half a dozen have been fitted with this type of turret which has however never been in use in battle but looks fair, in Mr. Crane's estimation, to further improve the handling of the guns in the turret, already difficult by reason of the heavier view of the target afforded by the present holes. Indeed, Mr. Crane advocates turrets entirely open at the top, holding that the chances of displacement from a shot falling in the turret are no more, as he makes the main working parts of the turret completely and absolutely immovable.

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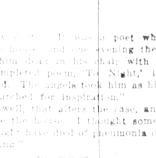
