RECLAIMING BAD BOYS.

Miss Lillie Hamilton French tells in the World's Work a pleasant system for boys who have been convicted for crime in New York is putting the boys in the straight track to many life and soul citizenship. For boys over 18, says Mr. French, "there was a place of detention, nothing except the penitentiary as a place of punishment. For the benefit of those boys, Mr. French volunteered to take under his charge as an experiment, boys between the ages of 16 and 22, who had been in the penitentiary for a term of misdemeanor, the court turned them over to him, paroling them instead of sending them to the penitentiary, or imprisoning them. During the course of the year there are sometimes as many as 1,000 of these boys arrested at that susceptible age when as one of the judges said to me, a few days in the reform school will act as a corrective, while a few months imprisonment will ruin them for life. One last year I got into the penitentiary and his hope for reforming the small boys must be saved in the first instance, or not at all. And the result? I asked one of the judges. "The result," he answered, "is that the boys are now better than they were when they were sent to the penitentiary. How nice they are, what promising fellows they are! They are now a goodly number of our best citizens. We should have been obliged to send many of them to the penitentiary, but we could not even have punished them unless in such cases what games would they have had? 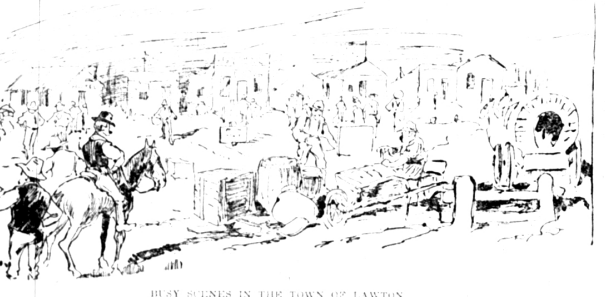
