Three Men Killed! ABOUT BOYS' CLOTHES.

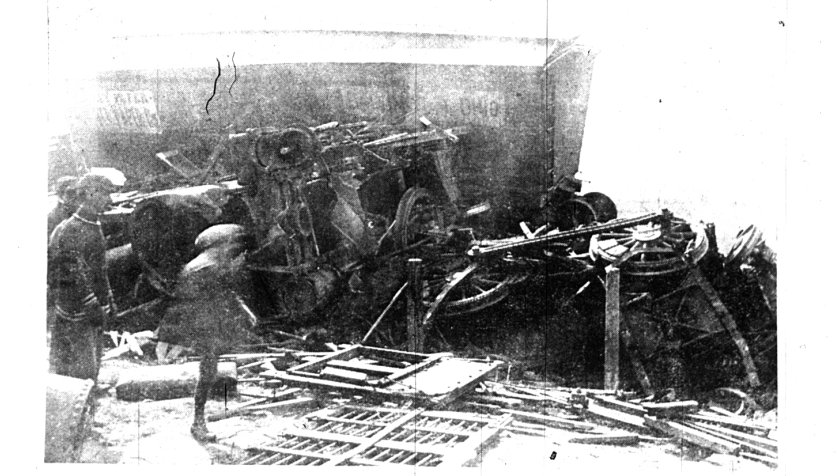
A Terrible Accident on the "Cold Reliable," D., G. H. & M. Railway North of This Village.

Stinchfield Farm the Scene of a Horrible Accident Due to Disobedience of Orders. Two Freight Trains Collided Above Place on Friday, Oct 18th.

Loss Will Be Over \$100,000. The Engines Wrecked and Made Truck of Nine Freight Cars Destroyed. Three Hundred and one Fat Boys Killed and Wounded.

DETROIT, Oct. 25.—The terrible accident on the D., G. H. & M. Railway north of this village, which resulted in the death of three men and the wounding of many others, and the destruction of property to the amount of over \$100,000, is being investigated by the Michigan State Police.

The accident occurred on Friday, Oct. 18, at a point north of this village, where two freight trains collided. The train from Stinchfield Farm was moving north, and the train from Detroit was moving south. The collision occurred at a crossing where the tracks of the two lines crossed at an angle. The engine of the Detroit train struck the engine of the Stinchfield train, and the two engines and several freight cars were wrecked. Three men were killed and many others were wounded. The property loss was estimated at over \$100,000.

When the wreckage was first seen, it was a scene of confusion and horror. The two engines had become hopelessly entangled, and the freight cars were piled up in a chaotic mass. The bodies of the two men who had been killed were found among the wreckage. The investigation is still in progress, and the cause of the accident is not yet known.

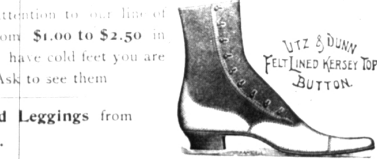
