MATTERS OF INTEREST TO AGRICULTURISTS.

Some Up-to-Date Hints About Cultivation of the Soil and Aids Thereof: Insecticides, Vitamines and Fertilizers.

Deep Rooting of Peach Trees.

How deep will peach roots grow? The answer is impossible to give at this time as not sufficient data has been secured to give the information. It is known that peach trees have a deep root system, that the depth of rooting of most plants is found on investigation to be greater than has been generally stated. In the case of the peach tree, the roots of each tree that was grown at the Panama exposition... The soil at each point the soil water or water table is found in this case. It will be noted that the roots reach a depth of 18 feet, and are then fairly well above the water table of good water in the soil.

The Numerical Expressions.
Deep peach root tree.
The first is the Australian salt bush. This is a perennial and grows to the height of 18 inches, forming a thick mat over the ground. It can be increased by cutting the stems into pieces and planting them in the soil. The second illustration is of the Mealy or Gray Salt Bush. It is a low-growing shrubby perennial, attaining a height of from one to two feet. The plant is coarse-textured and has a very thick, woody stem. It is a very hardy and useful plant, especially in the South and West.

The Rate of Nursery Stock.
At a recent convention of nursery men Professor L. H. Bailey said I quote from memory and may not be quite accurate in figures in every respect. Only one tree in five thousand lives. Only one tree in five thousand that lives gives anything like good results. The loss of seeds is equally as great. These facts indicate a great carelessness or lack of experience in planting trees or seeds. The loss is no greater than that which seems to be due to the natural forces of nature, but it is not the fault of nurserymen.

Mealy or Gray Salt Bush.
