WALK THROUGH FIRE

A well-known traveler who had spent some years in journeying round the world was asked to describe what he regarded as the most impressive sight he had seen. Without the least hesitation he replied, "The fre-walkers of Tahiti. In the year 1840, the French opened have since witnessed this mysterious pagan festival, not only in Tahiti, but in Fiji, and also in Japan, and more recently they have seen the strange fire-walking ceremony has puzzled experienced scientists, who have beheld it, and no satisfactory solution has yet been discovered."

Lord Stanmore, when governor of Fiji, once witnessed the weird festival on the island of Ngora. Before the ceremony they were dressed in the most grotesque manner. They were examined by the governor's physician and again after their performance they were examined by the British doctor. In this instance the Tahitians traversed a bed of white-hot stones several times, swaying their bodies to and fro, and the heat from the stones was so great that handkerchiefs thrown upon them immediately caught fire, yet the fre-walkers were not even singed, neither were their feet in any way damaged by the terrific heat. The head priest, however, who was the first to walk, and the astonished onlookers could only echo the words of Lord Stanmore: "Wonderful!" "Mysterious!" "Inexplicable!"

This curious heathen ceremony has not been performed so frequently lately in the South Sea Islands, the performance of the nature being taken by Papa Ika, in Honolulu, in the presence of several hundred persons. It is the last of a long line of such performances, for many generations have been immune from heat and fire, and a few facts about this extraordinary individual's feat will not be without interest.

A large square space was first dug up. Into this pit was thrown ten or twelve cords of wood. Upon this wood was placed eight or ten tons of broken lava. For six hours before the ceremony fierce flames leaped upward through the holes between the stones, and gradually turning them red, and finally white hot. Without fear or hesitation the aged man, dressed in the fantastic pattern of his own bodies, stepped upon the rocks and passed across the lava as deliberately as though it were a carpet upon which his bare feet walked.

For half a minute the lava's feet were upon the heated rocks. All this time he crooned the weird drape of the fire goddess and kept his wand of fat leaves always in motion.

When he reached the other side and stepped off, a physician came forward and asked to see his feet. The Tahitian immediately granted the request. They were unharmed, and there was no trace of any secret preparation or incantation which it was at one time supposed these savages rubbed into the soles of their feet before entering the fiery orb.

For half the fire-walkers stood upon the hot rocks, and walked to the center of the furnace, where he stood for several minutes, his hands being robes waving to and fro in the intense heat. He then called upon any one of these present to follow him through the furnace, assuming that they would

be protected by the fire. No one in the audience responded.
