The total production of crude petroleum from 1889 to the end of 1902 has been no less than 1,165,290,777 barrels.

Of this total, Pennsylvania and Ohio produced 53.9 per cent; New York, 11.9 per cent; California, 3.6 per cent; Texas, 2.1 per cent; and the rest of the world, 24.5 per cent.
