Foreign Representatives Are Forced to Take Refuge in City of Tangiers. FORMER BANDIT IS DEFENDER Soldiers Refuse to Assist Raulin in His Efforts to Defeat Rebels, Claiming Sultan Has Recalled His Appointment as Governor.

Tangier, Sept. 11.—Samuel R. Gummere, the American minister to Morocco, was compelled to abandon his legation in the suburbs of Tangier Sunday and take refuge in the heart of the city, owing to the battle between the insurgent tribesmen and the force under Raulin, the former bandit chief.

There is a general fear that the rebels will force their way into the city and that the fighting will be transferred to the streets. Raulin has summoned all his followers to his aid. He has 500 Moorish cavalry under his orders and four companies of Moroccan infantry.
