THE GALBRAITH LAW IS UNCONSTITUTIONAL, SAYS COURT.

COMMISSION MUST LEVY TAX ON THE RAILROADS AT \$7.50 PER \$100.

What the last legislature ought to do in the passage of the Galbraith law was held void by the supreme court in an opinion rendered, before, by Mr. Justice Black.
