The special car brought all back home at two o'clock a. m. full and happy. The full and the K. P.'s happy. Good-byes were ...

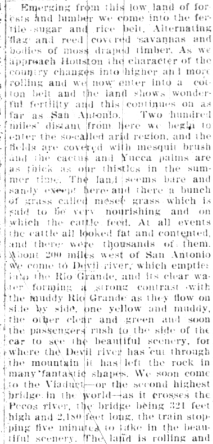
