FEW OF 10,000 ANALYSES

Among Them Artificial Water Submitted to New York Health Board.

There is an analytical department connected with the division of laboratories of the board of health, and any person who does not think that it is a busy department in its line, says the New York Sun. As many as 10,000 demands for analyses are made up in each year, and the diligence of those in charge is shown by the fact that at the end of the year there are never more than 20 or 30 cases awaiting a report.

Some of the demands are peculiar. One applicant demanded and obtained an analysis of a piece of soap; another, of "tea" said to contain opium.

There were two analyses of ginger-one of honey, one of hair restorer, one of orange marmalade, two of olive oil, one of pie, seven of opium, and one of whisky.

Only three specimens of candy were sent in for analysis during the period covered by the last report, only two of butter and only two of bread, but there was one analysis of an artificial watermelon, two of ground mustard, two of theater extracts, stores, one of "tea in pitcher," and one of a piece of clay.

There does not appear to have been any analysis of wood alcohol, but there were four of ice cream. There were also analyses of "tea" and "coffee".

The chief work of this department of the division of laboratories is the analysis of milk and water.

CRUEL TRICK ON TWAIN.

Freckled Impostor Played It on the Humorist in a Game of Billiards.

Mark Twain told the spectators at the billiard tourney in New York lately that he knew about the game.
