OBITUARY.

GALUCIA C. GIBBS. Galucia C. Gibbs was born on the home farm in the township of Troy on July 12th 1850 and died on July 18th 1906 having always lived on the farm where he was born.

He graduated from the University of Michigan in 1868, receiving the degree of A. M. and A. B. On August, 18th 1864 he was married to Miss Emogene Rhodes, who died Oct. 27th 1904.

Mr. Gibbs held many offices of trust and responsibility in the township and county and was greatly esteemed for his many admirable traits of character. Three children survive him, H. M. Gibbs of Howard City, Mrs. Henry George of Big Beaver and W. R. Gibbs of Three Rivers.

He was one of the oldest members of Birmingham, Lodge No. 44 F. & A. M., whose members turned out in good numbers on Sunday last, July 15th 1906 and paid the last offices of the craft to a worthy brother whom they loved and respected, W. W. Masters W. M. officiated at the obsequies, ably assisted by Chas. J. Shan.
