Wheat in Western Canada Real Estate Exchange

The grain crop estimates from the Canadian West make a range of from \$7,000,000 to 115,000,000 bushels, and an accurate statement will be some where between these figures—probably not far from 90,000,000 bushels.

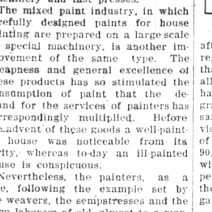
