Factors Which Influence the Value and Cost of Feeders—By J. H. Skinner.

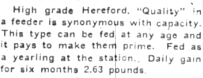
The production of cattle which will return a profit both to the producer and the feeder, is a problem which deserves careful attention.

The head should be broad, short, with full forehead, strong jaw, large mouth and nostrils, and from an either coarseness or delicacy.

A short, straight back indicates strong muscular development and a tendency to mature early.

Capacity for feed is essential in a feeder as the body must be maintained and provided with heat and energy before any of the feed is stored in the form of fat.

Short, straight legs together with a short, deep, broad body are associated with early maturity.



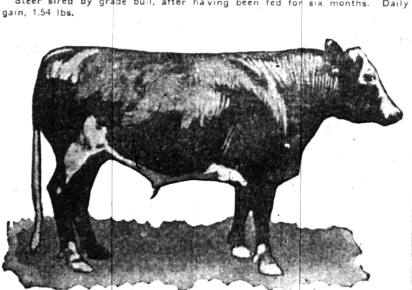
High grade Hereford. "Quality" in a feeder is synonymous with capacity.

It is of vital importance to the producer to be able to appreciate the factors which influence the value of food.

It was long after the establishing of the health farm that it became recognized as an important department of the Young Men's Christian Association.

In 1902, W. M. Danner, then general secretary of the Denver Young Men's Christian Association, presented the great need of the association to its friends and the public.

The committee was held every Sunday, at 8:15 a. m., and a twilight service at 6:45 p. m.
