STAYED CAVING WALL WITH BRAWNY BACK

WORKMAN SUPPORTS TONS OF DIRT ON HIS SHOULDERS WHILE COMRADES FLEE.

Seattle, Wash.—With the mangled body of one of his workmen above him, crushed beneath 12 feet of earth, and with two live men below him whose lives he had much to lose, a young man, A. F. Holman, a foreman for C. J. Erickson, supported tons of caving dirt in a narrow excavation on the street, between Fourth and Fifth avenues, long enough to allow the men below to escape.

With his broad shoulders pressed against the side of the car and his back against the stinging above him, he held up the caving wall with his brawny back.

Placed across the cut to temporarily check the caving earth.

Holman then reached by means of the ladders to the bottom of the cut and with the two workmen at the bottom caved through the upper pipe to the next opening.

The way up to the surface from there was easy.

Nicholas Klum, 21 years of age, was the workman killed. His body was dug out after four hours of heart-breaking work.

The digging was directed by Holman, the foreman, who worked like a demon, shoving himself whenever one of his men gave way.

The deep hole, 100 feet long and one-half wide, was dug down along Jefferson street for a sewer. The pipe had to be dug down low enough to conform with the new grade of the street, and it was necessary to dig holes every 20 feet.

In order to get the earth low, the bottom of the street is 10 feet to be shoveled into the hole. The dirt was piled up about eight feet from the bottom.

From there it was shoveled to an alley, and then to the street. Klum was engaged in placing the supports about the excavation to prevent a cave-in.

The foreman, who was on the first slanting of leading from the bottom, and Klum was standing on the second slant, and the level of the ground was so low that the men were unable to hold their feet in the mud.
