Van Buren County Where Law Has Been in Force 18 Years—Also Review of Eaton County's Long Experience.

Report Based on Facts Gathered by the Press Gazette in Company With Rev. F. E. Johnston of Holly—Statistics and Interviews.

PLAN OF INVESTIGATION.

With a view to ascertaining the general result of local option or county prohibition, as applied by Michigan and under the laws relating thereto, the Press Gazette some time ago made known its desire to investigate the subject. An invitation was accordingly issued to the county local option committee to accompany a representative of this paper to Van Buren and Eaton counties, for the purpose of making an impartial investigation.

On behalf of the county committee Rev. F. E. Johnston, of Holly, pastor of the M. E. church of that village was directed to assist in the work. The Press Gazette representative expressed a desire to send a representative and arrangements were made to this end. The person chosen, Mr. Lou Burdell, of Detroit, did not meet at the appointed time and hence his observations, while to be published, cannot be assumed to be of an impartial character, because they were made in the absence of the Press Gazette representative and the member of the county local option committee.

One of the agreements entered into between the Press Gazette and Rev. Johnston was that every fact, favorable or unfavorable to county prohibition, as shown by the investigation, must be included in the reports as published. An attempt was made to investigate every phase of the situation in Van Buren as well as Eaton. Facts were sought, unbiased opinions and, with the aid of the local option committee, individual interviews by local option or its opposition, chief reliance must be placed by the reader upon the general result or preponderance of reliable information, and experience, as elicited by the interviews.

No attempt will be made in the general presentation of the facts to argue favorable or unfavorable to the plan. It was thought advisable to allow the facts to speak for themselves, and the first opportunity to state the facts as they were brought out by the investigation. This report as published today will be followed immediately by one covering practically the same ground by Rev. Johnston. While these articles may differ in language they cannot represent much diversity of fact because, with but rare or four exceptions, each interview and item of information was gathered independently of the other.

Following the publication of these reports opportunity will be given for a summing up of the observations made; but such conclusions as are drawn must of necessity be influenced largely by the facts that are published and concerning which any intelligent reader is capable of forming opinions.
