The One Hundred and Seventy-Sixth Anniversary of Washington's Birth

George Washington was born on the banks of the Potomac, in Westmoreland county, Virginia, on February 22, 1732.

At the age of 16 he was a good surveyor and at 19 he was an adjutant of one of the Virginia militia districts.



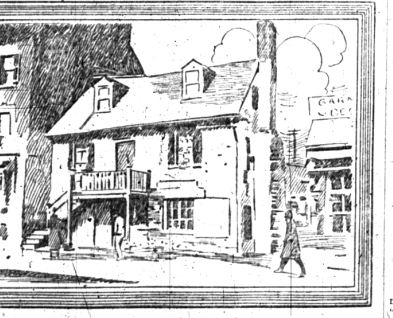
Woodland Mansion, Westmoreland County, Virginia, one of Washington's earliest homes.

During an eventful and successful military career, he retired to his home at Mount Vernon, Va., from which place in 1784 he wrote to Lafayette: "I have become a private citizen on the banks of the Potomac."

At the time Washington wrote the quiet words Lafayette had no thought that he would be called as the president of the republic, the living reality of which he had created.
