was no longer possible.

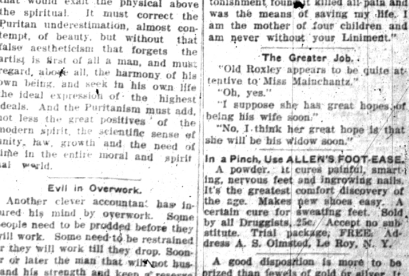
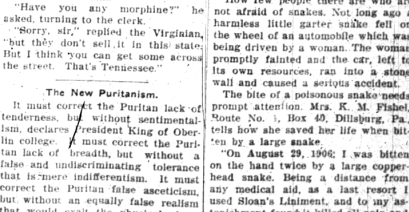
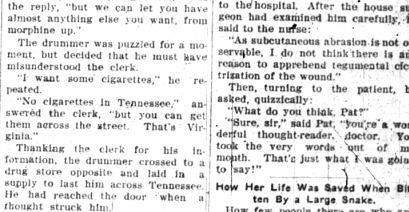
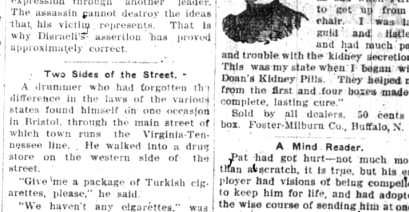
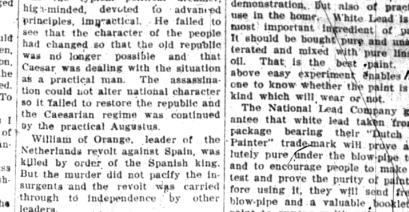
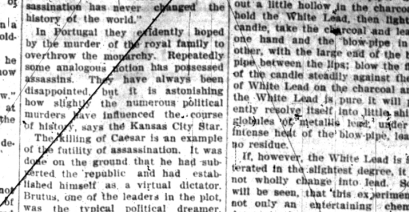
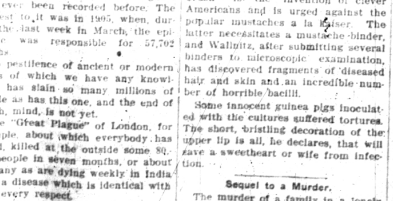
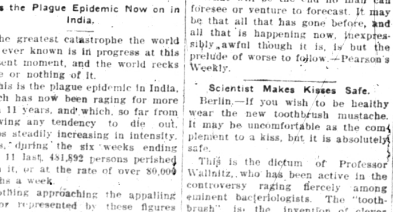
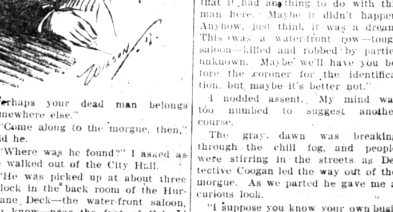
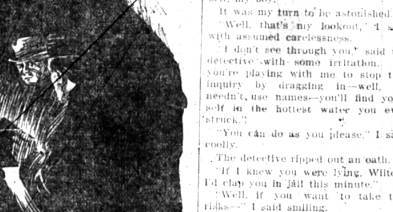
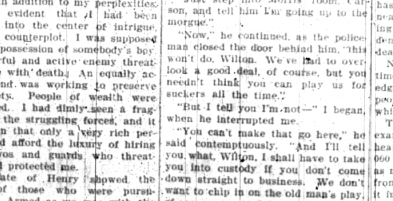
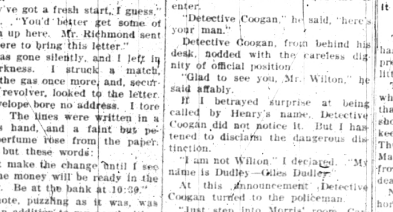
