A FARMER'S VIEW INTO THE STREET PROBATE JUDGE BUCKLEY'S DEED

Expresses Himself on the Mail Order Business and Gives the Home Merchant Some Pointers.

Local newspapers are expected to have a good deal to say on the evils of the mail order trade, and column after column has been devoted to the subject, almost invariably berating the farmers and others who manifest loyalty to their home town by swelling the mail order patronage. Like every other subject, there is something to be said on both sides, and the following communication from a farmer to the *Potterville Press*, at least furnishes some food for reflection. The farmer says:

"If the mail order houses get \$1,000 out of the county each month (that belongs to the home merchant), the fault is with the merchant themselves. The mail order houses advertise and give us prices on everything they have for sale. They tell us what they have and what they want for it. Of course we get soaked once in a while and if we do we can try some other firm. Most of the home merchant who advertise don't quote prices. They neglect to tell us what we want to know the prices. Of course we can go to the store and ask the price of this article or that, but you know how it is. One does not know so well what he wants to buy when he gets into a store as when he is at home. And here is where the mail order houses make their hit. They send their advertising matter into our homes and we read it when we haven't any other thing to do and every member of the family who reads their stuff usually sees something that he or she or some other member of the family wants and many orders are made up and sent out just at such times.

Right here is where the home merchant falls down. If he talked up his business to us in our homes the same as the mail order houses do, the people would begin to see them the next time they came to town and in many cases extra trips to get things at once that we did not know we wanted until they were brought to our attention.

The home merchant can save the expense of getting out a catalogue, and if the home merchant would talk business with us, let him put his talk in the home paper and put it in so that we know he means business. The merchant likely nine times out of ten, sells his goods as cheaply as the mail order houses and I believe on many things they are much cheaper, but how are we to know if he doesn't tell us about it?"

Several R. O. Lots Are Found to Extend--Error Discovered When Sidewalk Line Is Laid Out.

Litigation may follow the discovery that at least three lots on the south side of Eighth street, in Royal Oak, infringe on the street from 12 to 15 feet. The discovery was made when the village engineer surveyed for a sidewalk on the south side of the street. He found that the lots which were laid out with the Hudson-Hannah subdivision, extend out into Eighth street a width of 12 to 15 feet along the line of the street front yards of three houses will be sadly diminished and the houses are built so near the walk line that the front lawn will be spoiled.

The trouble is said to have arisen when the subdivision was platted. The original plat of the village gave Eighth street a width of four rods but the south side of the street was never fenced in and when the Hudson-Hannah subdivision was laid out the platters took about 12 feet more than they were entitled to. The plat was accepted by Royal Oak and stands recorded in the register of deeds office at Pontiac.

Owners of property along the south side of the street are wondering against whom they should bring suit. There is practically no dispute over the fact that the village owns the strip of 12 feet because of old law which has been located, showing the original width of the street. Lot owners will probably turn their attention to the platters of the subdivision who sold them lots representing them to be from 12 to 15 feet in width while in reality they are all from 12 to 15 feet short.

Popular Pontiac Alderman's End Hastened by the Result of Local Option Vote.

Pierre Buckley, for many years one of Pontiac's best saloon men, and a popular and influential member of the Common Council, died early Tuesday morning of pneumonia. Mr. Buckley had been ailing for nearly a year.

While returning from Detroit one evening last fall Mr. Buckley was taken with a severe illness and dizziness. He was confined to his home and for some time after apparently recovering he complained of not feeling well. When the local option question was first agitated Mr. Buckley took a deep interest in the proceedings and it was at his suggestion that what little work was accomplished was taken up in behalf of the "noets." Following the adoption of local option he began to fail. A stockholder in the Pontiac Brewery company, he of course stood to lose when that industry was put out of business by local option. Gradually his condition has grown worse and sleepless nights added to a system already taxed beyond its strength. Last week he was obliged to go to bed instead of rallying as at first he hoped he would be. He grew worse and Monday morning was able to recognize members of his family and intimate friends only with the greatest difficulty.

"Buck," as he was familiarly called by his friends and they are legion, will be greatly missed in all circles. He was generous to a fault, and no one in need appealed to him in vain, and any subscription for the public well always contained his name in connection with a liberal donation.

He leaves a widow and six children to mourn a kind and indulgent husband and father.

Funeral services will be held this (Friday) morning at 9 o'clock in the local church, Pontiac, at 9 o'clock, and the remains laid to rest in Mt. Hope cemetery.
