Isabella Bell was born at Rathfriland, county Down, Ireland, Sept. 25, 1836. Died June 1, 1908, at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. George Purdy, where for the past nine years she has made her home.

On Nov. 9, 1838, she was united in marriage to Robert Hanna, to whom were born 13 children, six sons and seven daughters.

In 1858 she and her husband and 11 children came to Michigan and settled on a farm in Royal Oak township, in 1873 moved to a farm in Southfield, and in 1880 moved to the village of Birmingham, where she has since resided.

At an early age she united with the Presbyterian church and when she came to Michigan she united with the Reformed Presbyterian church to which she belonged up to the time of her death.

She will be sadly missed by those who knew her to be kind, kindly, charitable, and considerate, she scattered goodness along the pathway of her life and her beautiful womanly character will ever be cherished by her friends and relatives as a tender memory of one who lived not alone for herself.

Her last days had in them all the sweetness and consolation that religion brings, and as we watched her take her last sleep and the spirit took its flight and we looked down at the calm face so peaceful in its holy and last slumber, we were reminded of those beautiful words: "Asleep in Jesus, blessed sleep, from which none ever wake to weep."
