MICHIGAN'S LAW

To Prohibit the Manufacture, Sale or Use of Adulterated Cigarettes, and of Their Use by Minors

An act to prohibit the manufacture, sale or use of adulterated cigarettes, and prohibiting the use of cigarettes by minors.

The people of the state of Michigan enact: Section 1. Any person within the state who manufactures, sells or gives to any one, any cigarette containing any ingredient deleterious to health, foreign to tobacco, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50, or imprisonment in a county jail for not more than 30 days.

Section 2. Any person within this state who sells, gives to, or in any way furnishes any cigarettes in any form to any person under 21 years of age shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50, or imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 30 days for each offense.

Section 3. Any person under 21 years of age who shall smoke or use cigarettes, in any form on any public highway, street, alley, park or other lands used for public purposes, in any public place of business, may be arrested by any officer of the law who may be cognizant of such offense, and the officer shall be the duty of all such officers, upon complaint of any person and upon warrant properly issued to arrest such offenders and take them to the proper court. In case the offender is found guilty, the court may impose a sum of not to exceed \$10, or imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed five days for each offense: Provided, That if said minor shall give information which may bring to the attention of the person or persons violating section two of this act, in giving to or selling, or in any way furnishing said minor person tobacco or cigarettes, and shall give evidence as a witness in such proceedings against said party, the court shall have power to suspend sentence against such minor person.

Section 4. Any person who knowingly harbors any person under 21 years of age, or grants to them, or permits them to shelter upon or frequenting any property or lands held by him, for the purpose of indulging in the use of cigarettes, in any form, shall be held in the same penalty as provided for in section two of this act. Provided, That no part of this act shall be construed as to interfere with the rights of parents or lawful guardians in the rearing and management of their minor heirs or wards within the bounds of their own private premises.

IN THE MIDST OF LIGHT WE ARE IN DARKNESS

Some Taxpayers Say Birmingham Cannot Afford to Be Up-to-Date and Lighted by Electricity 365 Nights Per Year.

And That the Old System of Partial Lighting Part of the Time Should Be Continued Till the Village Debt Is Paid.

The Estimated Cost of Gas Light, as in the Past, Is Only \$600 Per Year, Plus \$1,000 for the Purchase or Lease of Plant.

And Last, but Not Least, the Payment of a \$12,000.00 Mortgage, with \$720 Per Year Interest, and a Possible Large Arrearage.

On September 27, 1904, Miss Martha Baldwin sold to the Standard Heating and Lighting company, the property on Willits street occupied by the present gas plant, recorded in Liber 211 of Deeds, page 190. On Dec. 13, 1904, The Standard Heating and Lighting company became the Birmingham Gas company, recorded in Liber 214 of Deeds, page 248. On Jan. 2, 1905, The Birmingham Gas company executed a trust mortgage to the Detroit Trust company for \$12,000 to be raised in bonds numbering from 1 to 120 inclusive at \$100 each, dated Jan. 1, 1905, and falling due Jan. 1, 1925, 20 year gold bonds with interest at 6 per cent per annum, to be paid semi-annually. Recorded in Liber 157 of Mortgages, page 398.

The above mortgage statement is the hitherto publicly untold truth connected with the proposed purchase of the gas plant. After knowing this fact, a voter must be "Economic Crazy" who would vote our corporation to buy the aforesaid property sub-

ject to the \$12,000 mortgage, upon which the interest alone would amount to \$720 per year, and claim that he is doing it because our corporation is already in debt and we must be economical. Guess then our close friend taxpayer would have some reason to groan and sigh for something cheaper than daylight.

Possibly electric lights would cost the town a few hundred dollars per year. What if it? Better to do this than to burn our fingers by meddling with a property so deeply involved and from which no one knows what additional debts may arise for our corporation to become responsible for.

Have we been asleep for years as did Rip Van Winkle, and will we never wake up and come to our senses and see that a proposition which viewed from one side may seem to be the cheapest and best, viewed from the other side may mean the ultimate financial bankruptcy of a community.
