## SHOTGUN WAS WEAPON.

**Girl Bore a Spotless Reputation and Had no Love Affairs and Cause is Assigned to Melancholia.**

The verdict of the coroner's jury was that she died of melancholia. It was rendered at 1 o'clock Monday morning at the Boutin home, the inquest was held at midnight.

# INCREASING THE SALARIES.

An increase of \$16,000 for salaries of heads of state departments and some other high officials. That is what is already provided for in part by the new constitution and in part by pending legislative bills.

The new constitution provides a net increase of \$9,000 for heads of departments, those benefited thereby being the governor, secretary of state, secretary of state, state treasurer and land commissioner.
