"Window" in the Jungfrau. Another view toward the completion of the Jungfrau railway, the highest railway in the world, was accomplished on June 14. This was the opening of a "window" in the Jungfrau, by the great connecting wall between the Monch and the Jungfrau (called, at a height of 10,845 feet above sea level, 4,135 feet higher than the starting point of the line at the Little Schlegel, and 9,975 feet higher than the Interlaken. From this unique "window" a wonderful view will be obtained, embracing besides the glaciers immediately beneath it the peaks of the Schnehorn and the Lauterbrunn valley, the Wengernalp, part of Aar, and the Gampsegg of Lake of Thun. The "window" forms a ventilation shaft, and an outlet for the removal of the debris from the tunnel, which formerly had to be transported back of the Eimser station; lastly the short cut of having reached this spot is a vindication of the plan of a railway to the summit of the Jungfrau.
