The federal authorities at Washington have received word from reliable sources that on or about December 15, the revolutionaries will begin a widespread movement to wrest control of the Mexican republic from the hands of President Madero and restore it to the friends of former President Diaz.

The Nobel peace prize has been awarded jointly to the Dutch statesman of the Netherlands, founder of the Institute of International Law, and the Austrian peace advocate, Alfred Nobel, who died in 1896. Each will receive \$19,500.

A bomb explosion which occurred during the ethnographic exhibition at Liege, Belgium, resulted in the death of two persons and sixty-three others suffering from serious injuries. It is believed the bomb was thrown by a fanatic.

Eight foreigners, half of them Americans, were killed in Shensi, several mission houses were destroyed and \$500,000 Manchus were slain by Chinese, according to the first dispatch on the historic ridge where a Peking from Shensi since the recent outbreak there.
