Election and Registration NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the general village election of the village of Birmingham will be held on the 13th day of March, 1912, for the purpose of electing the following village officers:

One President, One Clerk, One Treasurer, Three Trustees for two years, One Assessor, Two Members of Library Board for three years, One Member of Library Board for one year to fill vacancy.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN, that the Village Council of said village, at a regular meeting thereof held on the 12th day of February, 1912, made and passed a resolution, which is the following in a true copy, to-wit:

RESOLVED, that the Village Council of the Village of Birmingham, does hereby declare itself in favor of said general revision of the charter of said Village, and that the question of a general revision of said charter shall be submitted to the electors of said Village at the annual general election to be held therein on the second Monday of March, 1912, and at all other times the question whether a general revision of the Village charter of said Village shall be made and submitted to the electors of said Village.

And the Clerk of said Village is hereby directed to prepare, give, post and publish all notices of said election and the submission said matter thereat, required by the statutes and laws of the State of Michigan.

And the following three electors of said Village, to-wit: A. W. Campbell, Frank Schieler and H. Wilson, are hereby appointed a board of election commissioners for said election to be held as aforesaid.

The board of election commissioners shall prepare and cause to be printed and distributed to the electors of said Village all ballots required or necessary for submitting said question at said election, and not less in number than double the number of votes cast for the office of Village President, in said village.

On said ballots shall be printed in one line the words "For a general revision of the Village charter, YES," and under said line and in a separate line shall be printed the words "For a general revision of the Village charter, NO," and opposite each of said lines and preceding the said words shall be printed a square.

And any elector in order to vote at said election upon said question and matter must put a cross in one of said two squares on his ticket and if he places such cross in the square in the line which says "YES," his vote shall be counted in favor of a general revision of the Village charter of the said village of Birmingham; and if he places such cross on said ticket in the square on the line with the word "NO," his vote shall be counted against the general revision of said Village charter.

The said election shall be conducted as far as submitting said matter to the electors of said Village is concerned, and the vote thereon, upon said question and matter, canvassed and reported, in accordance with Act, No. three, 63 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan for the year 1907.
