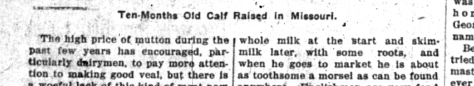

Ten-Month Old Calf Raised in Missouri.

The high price of mutton during the past few years has encouraged, particularly in the West, to pay more attention to making good veal, but there is a wooted lack of this kind of meat now on the market.

Most dairymen will not take the trouble to fatten calves, but send them to market just as soon as they are past the age limit, and the result is a calf that is nearly unsatisfactory, both to the seller and the customer.

Well fattened calves, weighing from 120 to 150 pounds, may bring high prices, no matter what the condition of the cattle market may be.

Many calves are sold when a week old, at 3 to 4 cents per pound, when if fed until they weigh 25 pounds, would bring double the money.

European farmers make good money out of the right calves. The youngster is carefully fed from the day the calf is born, with milk and a little hay.

CHEAPEST HAY FOR FORAGE IN WINTER

Second Crop Clover is First Class Feed for Cows and Sheep. Second crop clover is a first-class winter forage for cows and sheep.

In the grain-growing districts the second crop is usually very good. If the first crop is cut early and the stubble dressed with 200 pounds of plaster to the acre a good crop of second crop clover may be raised.

NEED OF MOISTENING CORN WHILE IN SILO

Excellent Time is When Crop is Too Ripe or Severely Frozen. Ordinarily corn cut at the proper time does not need any water added to make good silage.

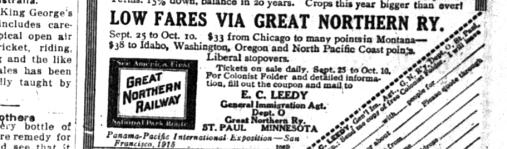

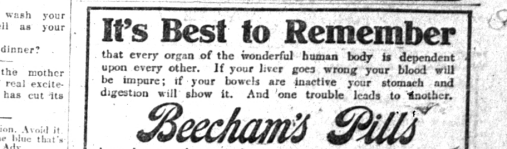
