Physical, Mental, Moral, Development Depend Upon Play. Who Will Help the League?

Play is increasingly necessary to higher stages of living organism. The child needs play, for through it comes the expansion of all powers physical, mental, and moral.

The child comes into the world, a tiny body full of capacities. The development of his character depends upon the contact with the family group, play group, and school.

The great problem is to get the moulding tendency, which is the great characteristic of childhood, in league with the wholesome. Three great virtues to be cultivated in children are honesty, health of sexes, and a spirit of helpfulness.

Dr. Henry C. Curtis, formerly secretary of the national playgrounds movement, says: "Any city may rightly claim an expenditure for playgrounds as social insurance."

Dr. Curtis says: "The reform schools, juvenile courts and other instruments for the direction of misguided youth would not be necessary if the nation as a whole would adopt the playground as the solution to the problem of what to do with the boy."
