All that portion of the town lying north of Maple and east of Woodward Avenue will be permitted to use water for lawn purposes

only from 5 to 7 o'clock a. m. All that portion of the town lying south of Maple and west of Woodward Avenue

from 5 to 7 p, m. We do not want the people to infer from this that there is a scarcity of water at the wells, but where the whole town is using water for sprinkling purposes at the same time, should a fire occur, it is simply impos-sible to get any pressure. DO NOT WASTE WATER, and should the fire whistle blow while you are sprinkling, SHUT OFF THE WATER.
