Give Concerts at the State Fair

Recent reports issued by the state railroad commission of Michigan, have shown that the Grand Trunk system had remarkable freedom from casualties during the year 1914-15 with only one passenger and four trainmen killed in the twelve months. Now it develops that in each of these four cases, the Grand Trunk was absolutely blameless, which makes the record even more remarkable.

The one passenger killed was Mrs. Mary Morrison, who jumped from a main near Clinton in small station on the Detroit, Grand Haven & Milwaukee railway. Investigation proves that she entered to the Pontiac insane asylum, Mrs. Morrison broke the glass in the locked vestibule door and plunged to her death.

Carelessness entered into the death of each of the four trainmen killed. Brakeman H. Reedy was walking on top of a train at Holly and fell off, December 22, 1914. G. W. Sizer, a yardman, was killed at Pontiac, February 2, 1915, while riding on the head-end of cars being pushed into a siding, a position he had no business to assume, according to trainmen. James Scramlin, killed at Goodells, April 12, 1915, fell from a train that was barely moving and met his death only because he fell on his head, while Fireman E. Leonard, killed at Flushing, May 12, 1915, carelessly walked in front of his own engine, while intent on carrying a jug of water from the depot to his cab.

This freedom of accidents in which the Grand Trunk could be held responsible probably says a record for the year among American railroads. Not one passenger or trainman met death in a wreck. This is so unusual that the reporter took the pains to take the matter up with the state railroad commission, before accepting the report as final.

Supt. John Ehrke, asked to what he attributed this record, declared, "Safety First."

"It is remarkable," he added, "to see how thoroughly the 'safety first' idea has taken hold of our men. They not only look out for their own part of the 'safety first' movement, but they watch their fellow workers—and the plan certainly pays."

LEWIS CASS CLIFF

Name Given to Park on Mackinac Island in Honor of Former Governor.



The citizens of Michigan are to do honor to Lewis Cass, a truly recognition of the able and faithful services rendered by him not only during his eighteen years as governor of Michigan Territory, but later in the United States senate, and as our representative to France during a trying period. The Michigan Historical Commission and Mackinac Island State Park Commission in designating permanent names for points of interest on the State Park have christened a park two hundred feet above the water level, "Lewis Cass Cliff."

A Lewis Cass Memorial Committee was named to provide the funds and erect a tablet, and the following officers were chosen: Governor Woodbridge N. Ferris, chairman; Judge Wm. F. Connolly, secretary; Col. Wm. P. Preston, treasurer, the latter being mayor of Mackinac Island. A call was made for contributions limited to one dollar from each person, and within two weeks a sufficient sum, more than five hundred dollars was secured.

The exercises connected with the placing and unveiling the tablet are to take place Saturday, August 29, under the joint auspices of the Michigan Historical Commission and the Mackinac Island State Park Commission. The unveiling of the tablet will be performed by two little boys each four years old. "Jack," son of Judge Wm. F. Connolly, and Walter Orin Briggs, son of Hon. Walter O. Briggs, secretary of the Mackinac Island State Park Commission.

Big Feature Announced For State Exposition.

A marvellously realistic battle in the clouds between two aeroplanes has taken place at the Michigan State Fair and will be presented at Detroit, Sept. 6 to 15 by the Patterson aviators.

Big Season of Year. The battle in the clouds is the nearest possible reproduction of the thrilling air conflicts that are being fought above the battlefields of Europe. It is considered one of the big sensations of the season. The Patterson aviators are today the most talked of flock of bird men on the continent. They have originated half a dozen absolutely unique programs. Their spectacular exploits in the aerobatic battle were made with the collaboration of P. S. Hamilton, director of the Michigan Naval reserves, Detroit battalions, formerly an official in the United States government powder plant at Indian Head.

National guard infantrymen, cavalrymen and marines are to participate in the battle and assist the defending aeroplane in repelling the invading plane. The war conditions will be adhered to. This will give the people of Michigan an opportunity to see warfare as it is today—completely revolutionized within the past year.
