MOLESKIN IS PROFITABLE

Moleskins have been extensively used in this country during the last few years in making fur garments, and practically all the mink and fox skins have been imported from Europe. In the belief that the common mole of eastern United States produces fur of equal value, skins were submitted to professional furriers, who stated that the quality is superior to the foreign product. A return on the economic value of the eastern species was established during the year. The mole inhabiting the northwestern coast is a species that the commercial furriers collected in order to obtain a report on the quality of the pelt.
