### European War News

Russians, thirty miles northwest of Lemberg, was captured by the Germans. The Russians are reported taking back all along the Lemberg-Rawa Rada line.

The French have carried Metz, in Alsace, by assault and have advanced to the German back toward Eberbach to the east in their drive toward the Rhine, says London. The Germans admit capturing Metz.

Gen. Christian De Wet, the famous Boer soldier, who was leader of the recent South African uprising, is being held in England on charges of treason. It is expected that he will be executed.

Herr Muller, convicted German spy, was arrested in London with Anton Kupfer, his aide. His appeal was dismissed.

A statement given out by the German admiralty Berlin is to the effect that the German submarine U-9 had been rammed and sunk by a British tank steamer after the vessel had been ordered to stop. It is expected to have an important bearing in the German-American negotiations.

Officially it is disclosed from Paris that the great French offensive movement north of Arras went through the German line of trenches. "We hold the slopes of hill 119," says the German statement.

Thirteen vessels, including six steamers, are known to have been sunk by German submarines in a week around the British Isles. They include one neutral, one Norwegian and three British steamers.

A dispatch from Copenhagen says that the German emperor himself has taken supreme command of the Italian campaign, establishing his headquarters at Pless, in southeastern Silesia, as near to the front as practicable.

The Russians are in general retreat along their entire front after having been driven out of their positions on the Veresov river, a short distance to the west of Lemberg, says report from Vienna.

### Domestic

Five intruders were condemned to die August 6 by the Mississippi supreme court.

The Carnegie Steel company at Pittsburgh, Pa., ordered the Homestead, Duquesne North works in Sharon, Pa., and Edgar Thompson plants to resume operations in full.

Seventeen hundred convicts, at a given signal, made a rush in an effort to break "Chicken Joe" Campbell, negro convict, suspected of the murder of Mrs. Edmund Allen, wife of the Illinois state prison warden, from his cell and Lynch him. The guards drove the convicts back.

Lashed and beaten into helplessness by merciless waves while being buffeted by an undertow, eight persons met heroic deaths on the beach at Atlantic City, N. J., while other heroes, red-shirted beach guards and bathers, fought desperately against tremendous odds to save them.

A proclamation of martial law at Atlanta, Ga., and the placing of a strong cord of National Guardsmen around Governor Slaton's residence were developments in a series of incidents growing out of the commutation from death to life imprisonment of the sentence of Leo M. Frank, convicted murderer of Mary Phagan. The call for the guardsmen was made after a mob surrounded the governor's country home. Troops dispersed the mob at the point of the bayonet.

Representatives of a life insurance company at St. Louis said that Robert C. Crow, a former state senator of Caruthersville, Mo., who disappeared in 1914, had been identified as an afflicted man in the United States army.

Edmund M. Allen, warden of the Illinois state penitentiary, is joint and sponsor of the "honor" system among the convicts, will resign. The warden's wife brought Mr. Allen to his decision. He announced his determination to his friends.

Grace Stewart Potter, pianist, for whose disappearance has been instituted following her mysterious disappearance in Chicago nine days ago, walked into the home of Mrs. Scott Demand at Lake Bluff, Ill.

### Foreign

The house of commons at London adjourned the imperial bill, the first reading of the bill providing the new chancellor of the exchequer, McKenna, with a blank check which may amount to \$1,000,000,000, \$1,000,000,000.

The Anchor liner Cameronia, which reached Liverpool from New York reports that she was attacked during the voyage by a submarine, which the captain believes is rammed and sank.

Dr. Anton Meyer-Gerhard, who sailed from New York on a mission to the German government from Count von Bernstorff, returned to Berlin. He had a conference with Von Jagow. The report that Dr. Meyer-Gerhard is in reality Dr. Alfred Meyer, chief of the supreme command of the German army, was denied authoritatively.

Grand Duke Constantin Constantinovich, president of the imperial academy of Sciences and head of the department of military science, died at Petrograd of heart disease at the age of 57. He was a member of the reigning family.

Count Zepellin, builder of German dirigibles, died in New York stricken with an acute attack of bronchitis and is confined to his bed at Stuttgart, Germany.

### Washington

Further representations are to be made to Great Britain by the United States government on misuse of the American flag by British merchant ships, it was reported at Washington.

Count von Bernstorff, the German ambassador, gave his word of honor to Secretary of State Lansing at Washington that the German flag would not be used in any way to aid the German Red Cross.

Peril of American settlers in the Yaqui valley of Sonora state brought orders from Washington for the dispatch of three cruise ships to the coast of Mexico, and authorization to Admiral Thomas B. Howard to land an expeditionary force if he thinks that the Yaqui are in danger of being first, carrying three companies of the Fourth regiment marine corps.

### Personal

E. H. Buck, past department commander of the Illinois Grand Army of the Republic, died at the home of his daughter at Danvers, Ill. He was 80 years old and was in Rock Island, Ill. Death followed a stroke of apoplexy.

## TEST OF BANKING IS STARTED

QUO WARRANTO PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST BAY CITY BANK.

## OF NATION WIDE INTEREST

Trust Companies of State Bring Action to Determine Right of Bankers to Do Certain Kinds of Business.

Lansing-Quo Warranto proceedings, the name of attorney-general Grant Fellows, were instituted against the First National Bank of Bay City in the supreme court Tuesday. This begins what promises to be one of the most important law contests in the history of the state and one which will be of nationwide interest. Permission for the use of the powers of the state to enforce the provisions of a general law in the quo warranto action was granted on a petition prepared by Henry M. Campbell, of Detroit, with whom is associated John G. Johnson, of Philadelphia, both of whom are acting in behalf of the trust companies of Michigan to determine the right of the First National Bank, of Bay City, to do certain kinds of business granted to it by the federal reserve bank to act as trustee, executor and administrator and registrar of stocks and bonds.

## JITNEYS HIT BY ORDINANCE

Drastic Action of Grand Rapids Council May Put Them Out of Business.

Grand Rapids-It is believed that only 30 jitneys will be put out of business by ordinance that requires owners to furnish heavy liability bonds and pay \$50 a year license fee. A new law will take effect immediately.

Rome—An Austrian submarine has torpedoed the Italian submarine Meusa, the ministry of marine announced. The Meusa was the first Italian submarine to be sunk since the outbreak of the war.
