MEMBERS OF BOTH HOUSES RETURN TO KNOCK OUT GOVERNOR'S VETOS.

VERY FEW SOLONS ABSENT

Republican Legislature Gets Busy to Set Aside Disapproval of Democratic Governor of Measure.

[By Gurd M. Hayes.] Lansing—Ninety members of the house and thirty senators responded to Governor Ferris' call...
