European War News

The important town of Tergovista, Rumania, has been captured by the Austro-German forces. The defeat of the first Rumanian army is declared Berlin to have been complete, and the Teuton troops are confounding their victories south towards the coast.

Two Belgians who have arrived at Stalskik, Holland, from Ghent, report that there was a revolt in Antwerp in which 200 to 300 inhabitants and many German soldiers are said to have been killed, according to a Reuters Amsterdam dispatch to London, quoting a Stalskik correspondent. The revolt was due to a call upon the inhabitants to work in Germany.

Russian troops have arrived on the front south of Bucharest and engaged in the great battle to save the Rumanian capital, the Petrograd and Bulgarian troops south of Bucharest have been compelled to retire. The Russians and Rumanians have taken prisoners and booty.
