A large radiator with extension tank, and large capacity in-take and outlet water manifold are a part of the radiation system of the new car. The exhaust manifold is unusually large. Large bearing surfaces for both main bearings, and connecting rod bearings, are features. The upper is of unit power plant type with three point suspension. Ignition is furnished by Willard Storage Battery and Atwater-Kent distributing system. For starting and lighting, the Ward Lamp single unit is employed. A ball duplex two stage carburetor is used in conjunction with the Carter gasoline system for carburetion.

The starting motor is mounted above the crank case, is connected with fly wheel, and is called back over the clutch housing. The transmission case is unusually compact and rigidly bolted to the crank case. The emergency brake is placed on the rear of the transmission housing. The Rocker shafts have been eliminated from the rear axle. The clutch and service brake pedals are adjustable. A double universal joint is used in connecting the propeller shaft with the differential.

Special aluminum piston of the hour glass type and light reciprocating part show the most modern construction which distributed to the high speed and efficiency of the motor. In addition to light quality the aluminum resists carbonization. A new place has been found for the power the pump on the left side of the transmission case under the floor board from which position it is operated by a lever which projects through the floor board.

The driving force is taken through the kind improved cantilever springs which are not removed from the rear axle and terminating in a ball and socket joint, in a spring case suspended from the center cross member of the frame. The brake system differs from the ordinary construction in that the service brake acts on the rear wheel drum and the emergency brake on a drum at rear of transmission. Both brakes are of external contracting type. Tires are sold here by Valentine & Smith.
