The Italians have been driven from their entire position on Lavarone plateau, the Austrian war office announcement says.

French infantry stormed and captured German positions in Fort Douaumont after a powerful artillery preparation.

The Supreme court at Washington annulled an unconstitutional Wisconsin statute which authorized state officials to revoke the license to do business in the state of any foreign corporation which shall remove its principal office from the state.

Testimony of Albertus Adolf Moore, the physician who attended John E. Peck, millionaire drug manufacturer of Grand Rapids, in his last illness, was given in the trial of the man who was charged with his murder.

A four-day convention, with nomination of presidential candidates on Friday, June 9, was announced at Chicago in the official program of the Progressive national convention.

A hint that he may "move over for world peace" was dropped by President Wilson in an address to a tremendous gathering assembled at Charlotte, N. C., to honor the little band of mountaineers, farmers who 141 years ago announced their independence of Great Britain in the Mecklenburg declaration.

Justice Charles E. Hughes of the United States Supreme court is leading in the Democratic preference vote for Republican nominee for president.

Several thousand rounds of shrapnel ammunition were received by the U. S. Army at Fort Belknap, N. M., aboard 22 trucks from Nantiquita, the most southerly of Gen. J. Pershing's chain of bases.

The firing columns of the Eighth and Fourteenth cavalry, detailed by Maj. Gen. Frederick Funston to give chase to the raiding parties of Gen. Sproles and Bujalinas, have returned to American soil near Boquillas.

Two troops of the Fourteenth cavalry are making a forced march southward from a point 40 miles below the river to Cerro Blanco to reinforce Major Langhorne's 50 troopers, who were reported at Marathon, Tex., beleaguered by several hundred Yaqui Indians.

The first act in the domestic tragedy of Claude Grahame-White and his beautiful American wife is set for hearing in the divorce court at London at an early date.

That Jeremiah C. Lynch, a citizen of the United States was condemned to death by a British court martial was officially admitted by the British foreign office at London.

By a vote of 60 to 37 the house at Washington, in the committee of the whole, adopted an amendment to grant suffrage to the women of Porto Rico.

Attempted frauds and evasions of the income tax law aggregating \$3,800, 185 have been frustrated by the treasury department, it was announced at Washington, during the first nine months of the current fiscal year.

The army reorganization plan developed in conference between the senate and house at Washington and providing for a larger standing army for the country, together with increased and enlarged defenses, was approved by the house by a vote of 249 to 25.

The administration shipping bill, designed to uphold the American merchant marine through federal aid, passed the house at Washington by a vote of 211 to 161.

The house naval committee at Washington voted to abandon the five-year building program, recommended by Secretary Daniels, and to recommend that the navy be increased to cost \$20,425,121 each; four scout cruisers, two torpedo-boat destroyers, 20 submarines, one hospital ship, one oil supply ship and one ammunition supply ship to be built during the fiscal year 1916.

THE AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE SUMMER SCHOOL WILL GIVE VALUABLE SERVICE

FARM BUSINESS IMPORTANT

Every Farmer and Farmer's Son May Acquire Knowledge of Great Value From Experts Who Will Instruct Him This Summer.

East Lansing—Farm business is a characteristic product of the new agriculture. Time was when self-sufficiency was the beginning and the end of farming, but the railroad, the interurban and telephone have changed all this and the market must now be listened to by the farmer in the same way as by the manufacturer and the merchant.

Marketing is perhaps the leading aspect of this new phase of agriculture and the big place that marketing has taken in the farm book of problems is caused by the fact that so much of the high prices which the consumer pays for farm products disappear before they reach the farmer.

Inseparable from good farm management goes the scoring of results known as farm accounting.

The higher prices for his products is the only way in which this most widespread epidemic has affected the farmer. He is a buyer as well as a seller and the doubling in the price of his products and other farm necessities in recent years has done much to cripple his gains.

The "get together" movement or co-operation has not been in vogue with college teachers. Business co-operation has indeed always received the approval of the college faculty since on the part of the co-operative movement within the state has been maintained upon the campus for almost two decades.
