About two years later this office was raided and documents procured that showed the work of the German spy ring in the United States under Ambassador von Bernstorff's direction.

Paul Koehn, stationed to conduct the secret service of the Hamburg-American Steamship company from a New York office, was discovered by the German spy system in the United States. He is now interned at Fort Detrick, North Carolina, where he was known as "XXX."

In a report by Koehn to his boss, Captain von Papen of the German embassy, Koehn described an agent who has made bombs to resemble lumps of coal to be placed on board the Hamburg liner. They must not be for the purpose of blowing them up white as it.
