**POULTRY**

CARE OF PROMISING PULLETS

Unprofitable to Waste Feed on Under-  
 sized Birds—Lay is Worthy  
 of Good Feed.

Prepared by the United States Depart-  
 ment of Agriculture.

It may pay to keep late-hatched pul-  
 lets that are well grown for their age  
 even though they should not lay until  
 midwinter, but an early-hatched pul-  
 let that is undersized at this season  
 will never make a good hen. To get  
 all that is possible out of all the prom-  
 ising pullets good care and good feed-  
 ing should be the rule at all stages. It  
 is impossible to grow pullets care-  
 lessly and on short rations until they  
 reach the age when they should be  
 full grown and mature, and then bring  
 them forward quickly by a short  
 course of good management.

A pullet that is worth keeping as a  
 layer is worth good care and full rations  
 all the time. A pullet that is not con-  
 sidered worth keeping should be eaten  
 or marketed as soon as she is eatable.  
 The one exception to this rule is where  
 there is more than enough waste feed  
 for all the poultry kept. Even then it  
 will pay better to sell the unthrifty  
 birds as soon as their character is ap-  
 parent and to buy good, thrifty ones  
 to replace them.

**DETERMINE SEX IN CHICKS**

Difficult to Distinguish Until Head  
 Parts Begin to Develop, Says  
 Oklahoma Expert.

A correspondent asks if there is any  
 way of telling a male chick from a  
 female when they are a week old. The  
 Leghorns are probably the quickest  
 breed to develop, but even with these  
 it would be a hard matter to tell a  
 cockerel from a pullet at so early an  
 age. You will have to wait until the  
 head parts begin to develop to have the  
 difference indicated, according to Prof.  
 Harry Emberton of the department of  
 poultry husbandry at Oklahoma A. and  
 M. college.

**FALL WORK WITH POULTRY**

Overcrowding is Liable With Growing  
 Chicks Unless Closely Watched—  
 Three Big Points.

Prepared by the United States Depart-  
 ment of Agriculture.

Growing chicks should be looked after  
 very closely, as overcrowding is liable  
 to happen, owing to the fact that the  
 chicks are getting larger and need  
 more room. This is a very impor-  
 tant point. Care given the flock at  
 this time means a profit; lack of care  
 a loss. The three important points  
 are (1) fresh air, especially during  
 the night, (2) fresh water at all times  
 and (3) clean quarters.

In every instance where egg pro-  
 duction is the end sought, the pullets  
 should be put into winter quarters as  
 soon as possible. Their winter quar-  
 ters should be ready in advance. At  
 this season cockerels should be se-  
 lected for next spring's broilers and  
 placed by themselves with plenty of  
 run if possible. None but strong, vigor-  
 ous specimens should be selected.

Culling can be done all through the  
 year, but at no time is it more profit-  
 able than at this season with the grow-

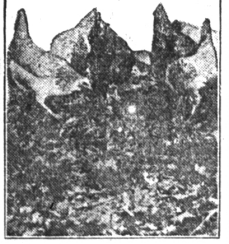

ing flock. All the wealkings should be  
 called at once. This will save feed  
 and give the stronger birds that re-  
 main round and opportunity to become  
 more vigorous. The laying hens should  
 be gone over again very carefully at  
 this time and inferior ones should be  
 taken out and marketed or eaten. Be-  
 sides culling for egg production, look  
 out for lice. Hens that have become  
 too heavy or too light should be dis-  
 carded.

 Produces—Cull the Flock.

 sumes more than she produces.

Go over your flock carefully and

**DID WORK OF HIGH ORDER**

Designs Wrought by Ancient Peruvian  
 Dyers Have Been Given Much  
 Praise by Experts.

The ancients of Peru, by a curious  
 coincidence—for there could not pos-  
 sibly have been any intercourse with  
 their contemporaries in India and  
 Egypt—seem to have used much the  
 same kind of processes in preparing  
 their designs upon the fabrics they  
 manufactured. Both Herodotus and  
 Pliny, among early historians, have  
 told us about the cloths of vegetable  
 dye made by the ancients; but in all  
 likelihood the fabrics of the Peruvians  
 were of even a more remote date. In  
 some respects the methods of today  
 bear strong resemblance to the older  
 practice. The chief difference con-  
 sists in the patterns now being en-  
 graved upon copper rollers and sev-  
 eral colors being printed at one time. Just  
 as today the coloring matter of dyes  
 is not affixed by merely printing it on  
 the material, but is secured by means  
 of a substance known as mordant, so  
 did the Peruvians make use of prop-  
 erty which caused the dye to adhere  
 and to withstand a test of thousands  
 of years' wear and tear. Experts have  
 declared that in the direction of tech-  
 nical and artistic value the designs in  
 question have no equal.

**MADE GERMAN AIRMAN SORE**

That Opponent Did Not Adhere to Or-  
 dinary Rules of Fighting Seemed  
 to Him Unfair.
